Title of the course: *Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi, myth, reality and thoughts*

Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi was not only a freedom fighter who contributed to Indian freedom struggle, his thoughts and philosophy also influenced many aspects. From spiritual aspects to economics, his thoughts affected various fields. He symbolized the freedom struggle. His method of mobilise mass in to freedom struggle was unique. Moreover, his politics combined spirituality to politics. He utilized new way of protests that is non-violent passive resistance; Satyagraha. He is globally well-known, however, complex character. His non-violent passive resistance was a great political strategy. Yet, his politics and philosophy were not without contradiction. Therefore, this course is introduced in order to explain myth and reality regarding M. K. Gandhi.

Twenty students enrolled in the add-on course this year. Prof. M. B. Deshmukh explained the autobiography of Gandhi i.e. my experiment with truth, Gandhi's experiments with satyagraha in south Africa. He also explained Gandhi's engagement in Champaran, Ahmedabad and Kheda satyagraha. He elaborated Gandhi's idea of harijan, women empowerment, nationalism and swaraj. Prof. Manubhai Makwana explained khilafat movement, non-cooperation movement, Quit Movement, Chipko movement, and *Narmada Bachao Andolan*. He also explained Gandhi's economic thoughts and his idea of local self-government. Dr. Vandana Parmar elaborated Gandhi's entry into Indian politics, his method of politics, mass movement and his idea of modernity. Later she explained how does Gandhian thoughts are relevant in contemporary world.
