Course Name: Translation Skills


Department: English

Translation is the communication of the meaning of a source-language text by means of an equivalent target-language text. The English language draws a terminological distinction between translating and interpreting oral or signed communication between users of different languages); under this distinction, translation can begin only after the appearance of writing within a language community. A translator always risks inadvertently introducing source-language words, grammar, or syntax into the target-language rendering. On the other hand, such "spill-overs" have sometimes imported useful language calques and loanwords that have enriched target languages. Translators, including early translators of sacred texts, have helped shape the very languages into which they have translated.

Prof. D.R.Mehta explained the importance of translation and translation competence to the students. He cleared how extra linguistic factors affect translation and threw light on monolingual texts. Prof.Rahul Patel explained the remaining aspects of translation with examples. He mainly drew students' attention on pragmatic aspect of the language, speech acts, and presuppositions. At the end of the course, he cleared textual features and the importance of coherence and cohesion to the students. On the whole, the course was conducted with Great Spirit and enthusiasm.
