- 4. Reporting and Punitive Measures: Students and parents are encouraged to report any incidents of ragging immediately to the college authorities. The policy ensures that strict punishment will be imposed on those found guilty after due process, which may include expulsion from the institution.
- 5. Compliance: The institution displays a statutory warning as mandated by the UGC, indicating the seriousness with which ragging is treated and the consequences for offenders.

In summary, the policy reflects a zero-tolerance approach towards ragging, aligning with UGC regulations aimed at maintaining a safe and respectful educational environment. It emphasizes both prevention through awareness and stringent enforcement through punitive measures against perpetrators.
